# CARBON & ENERGY

Reduce our energy use and carbon emissions in line with climate science

- Using IHG Green Engage, an innovative environmental sustainability tool that enables us to measure and manage our energy, waste and water usage, and target continual reductions
- Our Greener Stay program rewards guests for participating in our efforts toward conserving energy, water and reducing waste
- Installation of the Otis Link 508 NCE Regenerative escalators, including stop motion system, offering 75% more efficiency
- Use of LED lighting system throughout the hotel, including C-bus automated lighting and motion sensors to back of house areas



#### WASTE

Pioneer the transformation to a minimal waste hospitality industry

- Removal of all plastic straws, pens and keycards
- Refillable glass water bottles for all conferences and events
- Partnered Wallaby Water and installed water refill stations to reduce single-use plastic bottles
- Bulk-sized amenities available in guest rooms to reduce waste
- Work with Cookers Bulk Oil System to recycle used oil into biodiesel, and Bardee to collect and repurpose food waste
- Usage of general waste compacting system, reducing collections and related transportation



#### WATER

Conserve water and help secure water access in those areas at greatest risk

- Water efficient shower heads and dual flush toilet cisterns throughout the hotel
- All tapware throughout the building meets the WELS (water efficiency labelling standards) 4-star rating, in accordance with the AS/NZ 6400
